

Rules Rules and More Damn Rules

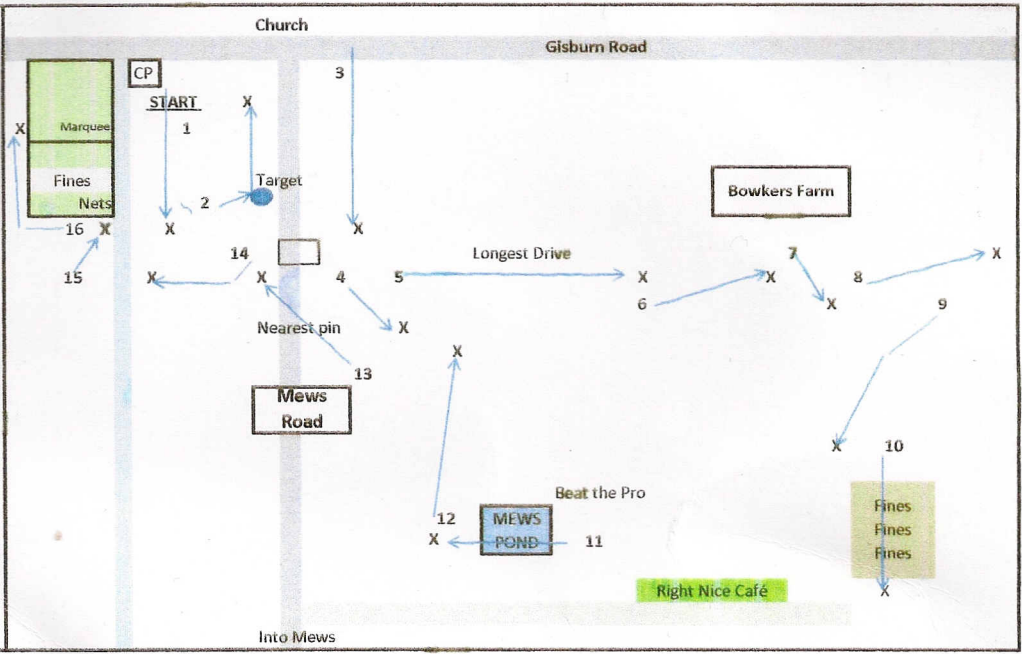
