2. Cacti or succulent
3. Gladioli (one spike)
4. Pelargonium (Geranium) in bloom
5. Vase of cosmos
6. Jug of marigolds
7. Flowering pot plant (not included in the above)
8. Container of any mixed garden flowers
9. Vase of three dahlias
10. Vase of sweet peas, 5 stems
11. Three stems of perennial blooms, single variety not named above
12. Vase of decorative foliage, 6 varieties
13. Three nasturtium heads floating in water
14. One spike multi flowered rose, any variety
15. One specimen rose
16. Dahlia plant growing in an 8" pot **MEMBERS ONLY**
